

Unit Two – Programming with Python

During this unit you will complete and submit four (4) programming sets using Python. Each will contain four "small" python scripts or functions that you will submit to Autolab for grading. Each program will either pass (a score of 1) or fail to pass (a score of 0). In other words, you will earn 4 grades on a scale of 0-4 for a possible total of 16 points.

This unit is scheduled to officially end on Friday, November 11th. All programs must be submitted for the first time by that date.

Final resubmissions to correct deficiencies will be accepted through Monday, November 14. After that deadline your Unit 2 activity grade will be assigned as follows:

Grade	Criteria
4	15 - 16 total points
3	All four sets contain at least 3 working programs
2	All four sets contain at least 2 working programs
1	All four sets contain at least 1 working program
0	Any zeros.
